



Art281 Vendor Guidelines

The mission of ART281 is to provide a one day venue for artists and art organizations to come together to display, promote and sell their art work directly to the public. In order to ensure the integrity of the show, ART281 has adopted the following vendor guidelines. All vendors participating in the show agree to abide by the guidelines set forth below. Vendors not following these guidelines may be excluded from participating in future shows.

All art, craft, and goods sold at the show must be handmade by the artist.

- Vendors will be selected based on merchandise to be sold, receipt of a signed and completed application, and proper payment. Vendor selection will be at the discretion of the ART281 jury. Preference will be given to members of participating/supporting organizations.
- ART281 has the right to disallow the sale of work not represented by the submitted digital photographs or website.
- Vendors must set up between the hours of 8:00am and 9:30am on the day of the show.
- Vendors not set up by 9:30am will forgo both their payment and access to the space.
- Vendors must remain set up through the course of the event with a representative for your work available in your booth at all times.
- All vendors must contain their display within the dimensions of the assigned space. Vendor's table must be covered and presented in a professional manner.
- Vendors must remove all items including trash, packing materials and displays from the property by 8:00pm. The area must be left in the same condition it was found.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting/paying Texas State Sales Tax (Comal County) as applicable to their product.
- The event will be held Saturday, 9 October 2010, regardless of weather. In the event ART281 must be cancelled a credit will be given to vendors for a future event.
- Returned Checks are subject to a \$35 NSF fee
- Application submission does not guarantee acceptance due to limited space.
- ART281 retains the right to terminate any activities or booth programs for conduct deemed, in ART281's sole discretion, unacceptable and/or detrimental to the mission and reputation of the event.
- The vendor releases and holds harmless ART281 and My Place Bar & Grille from any liability due to breakage, damage, theft, injury, or bodily harm while participating in ART281. The vendor also agrees to the above rules and regulations.
